1. How are you notifying citizens or property owners about this study? I am the address on record for this property and have not received any information. Without family members attending city council meetings, I still would not know about this study. Considering you are trying to get citizen input I think other methods need to be utilized.
2. Why is the city considering a Relief sewer alignment (Option C) when a more permanent solution seems to be needed?
3. Originally cutting through the Steeplechase property was not a good option due to the depth that would be required was considered unsafe for workers (Option C). What has changed in this regard to bring that alignment back into the mix?
4. Doesn't it make the most sense to follow the current easement of the railroad tracks that runs along the border of property lines as opposed to cutting through the middle of anyone's property that could interfere with future building or development?
